TSO recently made a donation to Kern County Tennis Association. They partner with high school tennis programs to help coaches and players acquire the racquets and other equipment they need to be successful. They sponsor free drills for jr. high and high school players as well as younger kids.

They launched the boys' high school season by donating over 100 racquets, 220 pairs of shoes, and 600 articles of clothing. The attendance at the drills and lunch exceeded 150 players - a new record for the boys. The funds you have provided are put to good use to support underserved youth in our community.
