Wimbledon Gala and Tennis Tournament Benefiting the MaxLove Project and The Teen Project

ocal Coto de Caza residents and avid tennis players, Santiago and Patty Rydelski, generously hosted their 3rd Tennis Serves Others (TSO) Gala on Saturday, June 3rd. The event honored the sponsors, donors, and beneficiary representatives of Wimbledon, TSO's annual fundraising tennis tournament and gala. The tennis tournament was held one week later, on June 10th.

The couple graciously opened their home again to TSO and Santiago, the master of ceremonies, delighted attendees with his humorous and fun auctioneering skills which once again pushed donations to over \$100,000. Auction items included custom destination home getaways, curated chef dinners, fine jewelry, and more. Patty and Santiago's huge hearts and helpful hands ensured that these charities received as much as possible and shared: "We have always believed that if you are blessed and you don't bless others, that your blessings will

Besides raising funds for these wonderful charities, the Rydelski's favorite part of the gala is "seeing our friends in something other than tennis clothes—no hats, visors, sunglasses, or headbands." The British-themed evening was a great night filled with a delicious dinner, dancing on a one-of-a-kind dance floor over water, and a wonderful auction.

The sold-out TSO Wimbledon
Tennis Tournament's 90 players and
local vendors (such as AMP Sports
Med & Recovery, Art of Grazing,
Jilly's Tarts, Aveda, and Wilson)
stepped in to donate their time and
talents to make the tournament a
memorable and enjoyable success.
From this year's record-breaking
fundraising, TSO was able to deliver
\$65,000 to each beneficiary.

Tennis Serves Others is a local nonprofit 501(c)(3) out of San Juan Capistrano with over 190 members and over a half million dollars in gifts and inkind donations raised over the last seven years. TSO continued to find success with their Wimbledon Gala and Tennis Tournament this year benefiting the local MaxLove Project and The Teen Project.

The MaxLove Project is an organization with a mission to increase the quality of life and reduce health risks for children surviving cancer, both in treatment and beyond. They offer whole-body wellness and nutrition support, along with education and research.

The Teen Project aims to provide a full life transformation to prior foster and at-risk young women who have survived human trafficking and homelessness by providing sobriety, psychotherapy, and a life-sustaining higher education.


TENNIS INCREASES LIFE EXPECTANCY!


